 Call for a fire engine immediately, even for a small fire. Please remember "Don't panic, act quickly and precisely." Stay calm and give the operator the following information.
 • Location of the fire and nearby landmarks
 • What is on fire
 • If anyone has failed to escape or is injured
 Say "Kaji-da (Fire)!" in a loud voice to inform your neighbors and ask for their cooperation.
 < Installation of Fire Alarm for Housing >

 (Fire Department, Prevention Section) Tel. 048-775-1314
 It is mandatory to install fire alarms in newly built houses as well as all existing houses. Fire alarms sense fires at early stage and alert.

外国人住民の人も転入・転居・転出などの届け出が
必要です。

外国籍の人（観光目的などの短期滞在を除く）が日本
国内に住所がある場合、住所の届け出（転入・転出等）
が必要になります。この届け出に基づき日本人と同様に
住民票が作成され、住所や転入・転出事項、家族
構成などが記録され、申請により証明書が交付されます。

また、この情報に基づいて、さまざまな行政サービスが
行われます。

All non-Japanese living in Japan, just like Japanese
residents, need to notify their local municipality of their
address when moving in, moving out, or changing address
within the city (temporary visitors, such as tourists, are
excluded from this requirement).

This notification allows non-Japanese residents to be eligible
for certificates of residence (*Jyumin-hyo*), on which their
address, moving-in and moving-out information, and their
family members are recorded, exactly as Japanese residents
are. A copy of your *Jyumin-hyo* will be issued at the city
offices upon request. Also, your *Jyumin-hyo* makes you
eligible to receive various services from the city.

国民健康保険

国民健康保険とは、病気やけがをしたときに加入者の皆さんがお金(保険税)を負担し合って、医療機関にかかるときの医療費に充てる、助け合いの制度です。

住民登録をしていて、他の保険に加入しておらず、3か月を超えて日本に滞在する場合、国民健康保険に加入することになっています。国民健康保険に加入すれば、医療機関が行うほとんどの診療・検査について、年齢に応じ70%または80%が保険によって支払われることになります。

保険税は、各人の前年の所得によって決まります。

※75歳以上の方は、後期高齢者医療制度に加入します。(12番窓口)

National Health Insurance is a cooperative system in which subscribers contribute money (insurance tax) to cover medical expenses generated in medical institutions in case of illness or injury.

If you are registered as a resident, do not have any other insurance, and stay in Japan for more than three months, you will be required to join the National Health Insurance system. If you enroll in the National Health Insurance, the insurance will pay 70% - 80%, depending on your age, of most medical examinations and treatments performed by medical institutions. Insurance taxes are determined by each person's income from the previous year.

加入者が納める保険料と国の負担金によって、国が責任をもって運営する制度で、病気やけがになったとき、また、高齢になったときに皆で助け合い、生活に不安がないようにしていこうという制度です。

◇ 住民登録をしている20歳以上60歳未満の方で、厚生年金に加入していない方は、国民年金に加入することになります。

◇ 保険料は、年齢・性別・所得に関係なく一律です。

National Pension Plan / Kokumin Nenkin

This pension plan is responsibly operated by the National Government with premiums paid by subscribers and government subsidy. It is a mutual aid system designed to provide financial security when the subscribers become ill, injured or old.

◇ All registered residents of Japan between 20 and 59 years of age are required to join the National Pension Plan. (Exclusion offered to those subscribing to other pension plans, such as the Employee's Pension Insurance Plan / Kousei Nenkin).

◇ The premium is uniform regardless of age, gender or income.

納税義務者となるのは、毎年1月1日時点で、市内に住んでいて、前年(1月~12月)に所得のあった人です。ただし、外国人住民で日本での滞在が短期間(約3か月以内)の場合は、税金がかかりません。

Taxpayers are those who live in the city as of January 1st of each year and had income in the previous year (January through December). However, foreign residents whose stay in Japan for a short term (approximately 3 months or less) are not subject to tax.

<Light vehicle Tax>

住民票のある方がひとりひとり持つ、12ケタの番号で、一生使うものです。税金・保険・年金などの管理のために使われます。

個人番号通知書についている個人番号カード交付申請書を使用して、マイナンバーカードを申請できます。マイナンバーカードは身分証明書として使え、

コンビニで住民票の写しが取れるなど、便利な機能があります。



My Number, My Number Card

'My Number' is a 12-digit number, given to every individual registered as a resident in Japan. Once your number is issued, it will be used for the rest of the time you reside in Japan in order to manage your tax, health insurance, pension and so on.

If you wish to have your 'My Number Card' issued, you can apply for it by using the Individual Number Card Issuance Application Form which is attached to your Personal Number Notice Letter. The 'My Number Card' has useful functions. For example, you can use it as your ID to obtain a copy of your Residence Certificate (Jyumin-hyo) at a convenience store.

Once pregnancy has been confirmed, please submit a pregnancy notice at the Higashi Hoken Center (East Public Health Center) or Children and Families Comprehensive Support Center on 5F of City Hall. After the notification has been submitted, you will be issued a "Boshi Kenkou Techo." In order to have the "Boshi Kenkou Techo" issued, your "My Number Card" or "My Number Notification Card, (only when the information matches the person's name, address, etc)" and your ID such as Residence Card are necessary. This handbook records health conditions of both mother and child and is useful throughout the child's life. In addition, you are required to bring this handbook with you when receiving health services provided by Ageo City.

A subsidy coupon for 14 times of health examinations for pregnant women, newborn hearing tests, and maternity health examinations will be issued at the time of issuance of the Mother and Child Health Handbook.

Household garbage must be separated and disposed of according to types, such as burnable (including plastics), non-burnable (metal・ceramics・Rechargeable Small Home appliances), and recyclable items (PET bottles・Beverage can・spray can・glasses・paper・cloth). Please separate your garbage properly, and put the separated garbage out by 8:00 a.m. at the designated site on the specified days. For collection schedules and disposal rules, please see the “Garbage Collection Calendar (Gomi Shushu Calendar).”

● Small-size rechargeable batteries are collected at electric appliance stores and home improvement centers. However, those used in electric appliances such as heated tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, electric shavers, electric tooth brushes and mobile batteries are difficult to remove. Please do not try to break up a product to take out the battery, as it may ignite. If you have one of these items, please bring it as is to one of the following public facilities:

Ageo City Hall, branch offices, or Nishi-Kaizuka Environment Center, and place it in the “Compact Appliances Collection Box” located at the facility.

Small-size rechargeable batteries include NiCad batteries, nickel batteries and lithium-ion batteries, which are incorporated in the following products:

Digital cameras, video cameras, portable DVD players, laptop computers, mobile phones, portable game players, vacuum cleaners, power-assisted bicycles, heated tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, electric shavers, electric tooth brushes, mobile batteries, etc.

Is your family prepared for an earthquake? Let's check! When a massive earthquake strikes your area, you may not be able to use water, electricity and gas. Have a survival kit ready. Also have a discussion among your family members about emergency evacuation and how to contact other.



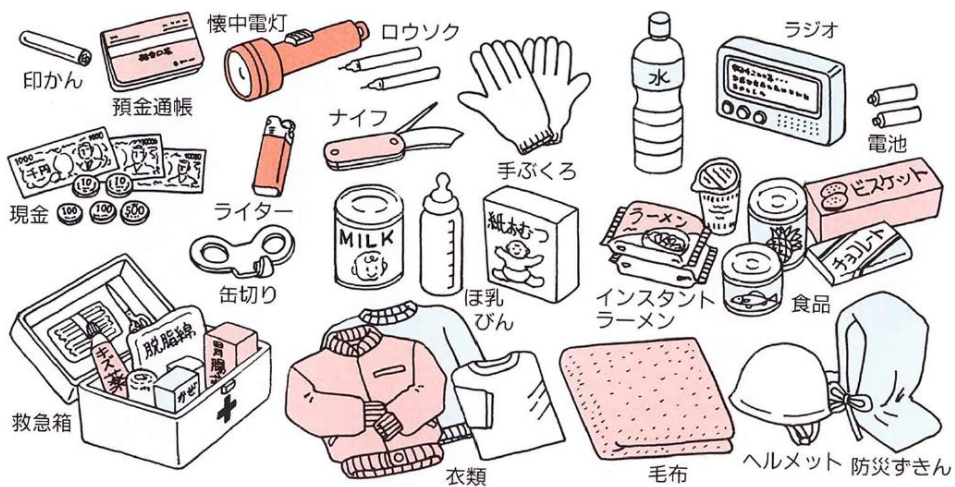

What to do if an earthquake hits your area?

- 1) You and your family's safety are most important. Take shelter under a table. Do not walk around barefoot.
- 2) Turn off burning devices.
- 3) Open doors to secure escape routes.
- 4) Extinguish any small fires quickly.
- 5) Confirm safety first and evacuate calmly.
- 6) Stay away from concrete-block walls and gateposts.
- 7) Evacuate on foot. Take the minimum necessary items with you.
- 8) Cooperate your neighbors and lend a helping hand to the elderly and children.
- 9) Follow instructions of city officials, fire brigade members and police officers, and act calmly.

Survival Kit

Food (canned food and Kan-pan/dry biscuits for emergency), Can opener, Candle, Cotton work gloves, Water, Clothes, Money, Bank book, Passport, Health Insurance Card, Seal (Hanko), Batteries, Flashlight, Matches, Small knife, First aid kit (medicines, Sticking plaster and scissors, etc.), Radio, Tissue paper, Ball-point pen, Hard hat, Baby formula and diapers (if you have a baby).

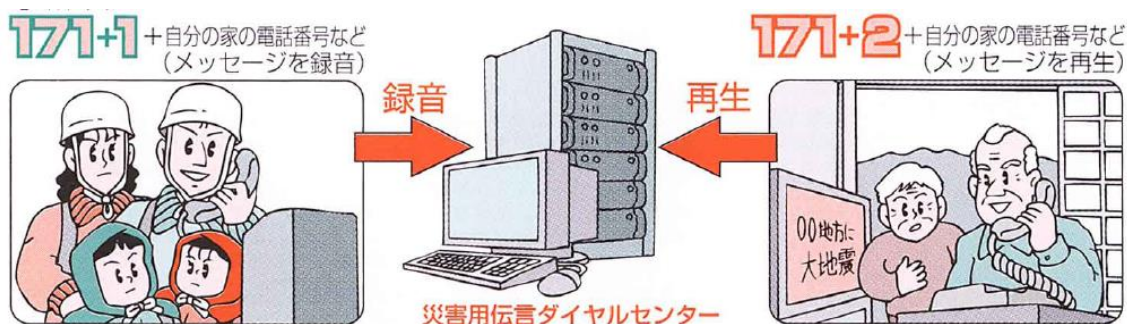

JAPANESE HOSING

1. Private Housing

When looking for a place to rent, you should consult a real estate agent in the area in which you want to live. There are many special procedures involved when entering into a lease contract in Japan. Consequently, an understanding of these procedures and Japanese customs is essential to ensure that your move goes as smoothly as possible.

(1) Information on Private Housing

Rent and Management Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Rent is paid monthly in advance. ▶ A management or common service fee for common facilities used with other tenants, such as a cleaning service and common lights is added to the rent.
Size of House and Rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ The size of a house is indicated by the total floor space, including not only living areas, but also the toilet, bathroom and kitchen. It is usually measured in square meters (e.g. 30m²). ▶ The size of each room is indicated by the number of tatami mats that can be laid on the floor. One <i>jō</i> (tatami mat) is about 1.6m². The rooms are categorized as either Japanese or Western style.
Utilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Basic wiring and piping for utilities such as electricity, water and gas are supplied. However, to use these utilities the tenant must contact the respective companies. ▶ Houses do not come furnished, nor are gas ranges or light fixtures provided.
Location	Location is usually indicated in number of minutes from the nearest station (e.g. A 15-minute walk from Ageo Station).

(2) Before Entering into a Lease Contract

A lease contract clearly specifies the rights and obligations of both the tenant and landlord. Your signature on such a contract is legally binding and indicates that you agree to and will abide by the terms and conditions listed therein. It is therefore imperative that you understand the contents of the contract before signing. When entering into a lease contract, you are required to present your Resident Card (Alien Registration Card), a certificate of income and your name seal certificate. A guarantor or written oath is also usually required.

(3) Payment Required when Entering into a Lease Contract

Rent (<i>yachin</i>)	Rent is paid in advance. Therefore, when first moving into a property, you have to pay 2 months' rent (the current and the following month). Rent is usually paid by bank transfer.
Deposit (<i>shikikin</i>)	A deposit of 1-3 months' rent is given to the landlord when you sign the lease contract. This money is used to pay any outstanding rent and expenses for repairing the property. The balance, if any, is refunded to you when you move out.
Key Money (<i>reikin</i>)	Generally 1-2 months rent is paid to the landlord as key money. This money is non-refundable.
Realtor's Fee (<i>chūkairyō</i>)	This is the commission paid to the real estate agent. In principle, the tenant and landlord each pay the equivalent of half a month's rent, total 1 month's rent. However, if both parties agree, the proportion paid by each party may be changed.
Contract Renewal (<i>keiyaku kōshinyō</i>)	The duration of a lease contract is usually 2 years. When renewing a lease contract, a renewal fee equivalent to 1 month's rent is sometimes charged.

(4) General Terms and Conditions of a Lease Contract

Guarantor	Often you need to have a guarantor when applying for an apartment. If you do not have a guarantor you may discuss with the agent the option of using a company that supplies guarantors.
Payment of Rent	Rent must be paid 1 month in advance by the date stated in the lease contract.
Occupants	You cannot allow anyone other than family members to live with you without the prior consent of your landlord.
Subletting	You cannot sublet any or all of the property to a third party.
Renovating and Redecorating	You must obtain your landlord's permission before installing or changing fixtures such as gas piping or electric wiring, renovating or redecorating the premises.
Lease Termination	When terminating a lease prior to its full term, you must notify your landlord of your intention to do so. This notification must comply with the time frames stated in your lease contract. If you terminate the lease without notifying your landlord, your deposit will not be refunded.
Conditions at the End of the Lease	Be aware that there are instances where deposits are not returned and exorbitant cleaning charges are made at the end of leases. You should agree as to what fees will be required at the end of the lease before you sign.
Pets	Most landlords do not allow pets. Therefore, if you wish to keep a pet, please clarify this point with the real estate agent before entering into the lease contract.

2. Public Housing

Saitama provides public housing for low-income residents. Tenants are chosen by way of lottery, due to the extensive number of applications. Applications are accepted during the months of January, April, July, and October.

Individuals meeting the following requirements are able to apply:

- a) If you are a foreign national, you need to have a valid visa and be registered.
- b) You must be able to demonstrate that you are in need of a residence.
- c) You have family (i.e. a spouse or first relative) living with you (except if applying for individual residence).
- d) You reside or work in Saitama.
- e) The income of your household is at or below the designated amount.
- f) You have paid your prefectural municipal tax.
- g) You are not in arrears with rent or damage compensation owed to public housing (housing developed by regional public groups, Urban Renaissance Agency, or a local housing corporation).
- h) You or your family is not part of a crime syndicate.
