Ageo City Libraries

User Guide

For first-time users

- A library user card is needed to borrow materials from a library.
- If you live, work or go to school in Ageo, or live in either Saitama-shi, Hasuda-shi, Okegawa-shi or Ina-machi, you are eligible to have the library user card issued.
- Please bring an identification document that verifies your name and address (such as a
 driving license or a health insurance card) to the registration counter. If you work or go to
 school in Ageo, please bring a document to prove it as well.
- Library user cards can be used at any library in Ageo.
- Library user cards are valid for 3 years. Registration needs to be renewed every 3 years.

To borrow

- Please be sure to use your own library user card.
- Please bring materials you wish to borrow and your library user card to the counter.

- Some materials including the latest issue of magazines and reference-use materials cannot be removed from the library.
- When elementary school and/or preschool children borrow audio/visual materials such as CDs, their guardians are required to come along.
- Long-term loan to organizations in Ageo is also possible. For more details, please ask a staff member at the counter.

To return

- Please return materials at the counter. It's not necessary to show your library user card upon return.
- Materials possessed by Ageo City can be returned at any library in Ageo.
- When the library is closed, place them at the "Book Post (Henkyaku Post)."
 - Book Posts are located at all the libraries, at JR Kita-Ageo Station (in front of the ticket gate) and at JR Ageo Station West Exit (by the elevator).
 - Audio/visual materials such as CDs should be directly returned at the counter during the library hours.
- Please return by due date!
 If you have overdue borrowed materials, you may not be allowed to check out other items.

To look for materials

- With a terminal for library users (OPAC), you can check what each city library holds and the availability of materials.
- When you cannot locate the book that you are looking for, please ask a staff member.
- As for books that are out on loan or not held by any city libraries, you can request them, up to 10 books per person.

< Reservation of materials >

To reserve books, please fill out a request card and submit it to the counter.

- As for audio/visual materials such as CDs held by libraries, you can reserve three items at one time. To reserve, please fill out a request / reservation card and submit it to the counter.
- * There are some items which cannot be requested. Please ask at the counter for details.

If you don't know how to search

- A library staff member will assist you. Feel free to ask for their help.
- < Copying service >
- You can copy materials as long as it does not violate the Copyright Act.

Library Sites

- Various information, such as a calendar for opening days and event schedules, is posted on the site.
- Materials held by libraries can be searched.
- By registering your password, you can reserve materials and confirm materials you are currently borrowing and also the status of reservation on the sites. To register, show your library user card and an identification document that verifies your name and address at the counter.

- How to sign in to the Ageo City E-Library:
 - · Input Ageo City library user card number (excluding hyphen)
 - Input the initial password: 8 digits of your date of birth (1981/6/2 \rightarrow 19810602)
 - If you don't have a library user card, please register as a user at the library counter, where a temporary number will be given.
