Application Procedures for Overseas Medical Treatment Expenses for Ageo City National Health Insurance

1. Treatment eligible for overseas medical expenses

- Ageo City National Health Insurance subscribers had no choice but to visit overseas medical institution.
- The treatment is covered by Japan's Health Insurance.
- Documents prepared and issued by the medical institution confirming the date of examination, the name of the disease, the details of treatment and the amount received.
- · Procedure within 2 years from the date of treatment.



In the following cases, overseas medical treatment expenses are not eligible for payment.

- O Traveled for therapeutic purposes
- O Treatment not covered by Japan's Health Insurance
- O There are no documents, more than 2 years have passed since the treatment, etc.
- O Non-medical treatment (prosthetics, acupuncture and moxibustion, or massage therapy)

2. Amount of Overseas Medical Treatment Expenses Payment

- The lower of the amount for treatment in Japan for a covered illness or the amount of medical expenses incurred locally will be covered, and the amount equivalent to the co-payment will be deducted from the covered amount. If you are covered by public insurance overseas, the amount will be calculated after deducting the amount covered by public insurance.
- * Overseas, even for the same illness or injury as in Japan, the amount of the claim may differ greatly depending on the country and medical institution, so please purchase private overseas travel insurance if necessary.

3. Documents to be submitted and their description

- ① Application form for payment of National Health Insurance medical treatment expenses and transportation expenses
 - It is necessary to submit one sheet for each insured person.
 - Don't forget to list the country and currency where you received the treatment.
 - Fill in the shaded part of the application form. (The designated account is in the name of the head of household.) If you want to specify an account for someone else, you must fill in the Authorization to Receive column.)

2 Attending Physician's Statement (Form A) (Form C for Dentistry)

- Please ask your doctor to fill out the prescribed form (Form A). (one for each month, one for inpatient and one for outpatient)
- Please fill in the Japanese translation on the form or prepare a separate translation and submit it.
- The certificate issued by medical institution confirming the date of examination, the name of the disease, and the details of the treatment can be accepted even if it is not on the prescribed form.
- In the case of dentistry Form C Dental Statement Submission is required.

3 Itemized Receipt (Form B)

- Please ask your doctor to fill out the prescribed form (Form B).
- · Please indicate the currency unit in the margin.

4 Original Receipt

- Be sure to submit the original <u>receipt issued by medical institution</u>. Without the receipt, the overseas medical treatment expenses cannot be examined and will not be accepted.
- · Please prepare and submit a separate translation.

⑤ Passport

- Must be able to confirm entry into and exit from the country where the medical treatment was received and return to Japan at the time of application.
- If you use an automated immigration gate at the airport, your passport will not be stamped. Please ask an officer to stamp your passport when you pass through the gate.
- If you used the automated immigration gate and did not have your passport stamped, please submit documents showing the date of entry/exit (air ticket stub(original), copy of record from a request for disclosure of your entry/exit(return) record at the Ministry of Justice, etc.) with your passport.
